**Facilities Design and Construction**  
**Value Engineering**

This policy supersedes Policy 8275.

**I. PURPOSE**

To establish the use of value engineering for school construction projects to obtain quality project design and construction at the lowest possible cost.

**II. DEFINITION**

Value engineering (VE) is defined as the systematic application of recognized techniques by a multidisciplined team (or teams) that identifies the function of a product or service; establishes a worth for that function; generates alternatives through the use of creative thinking; and provides the needed functions reliably and at the lowest overall cost.

**III. IMPLEMENTATION**

|| The Division Superintendent shall establish regulations and procedures to require that all school construction projects be value engineered as standard practice.
