Student Responsibilities and Rights

Prevention of Alcohol and Other Illegal Drug Use by Students

This policy supersedes Policy 2150.1.

I. PURPOSE

To establish policy with regard to alcohol and other illegal drug use on school property and guidelines that promote a safe, alcohol-free, and drug-free learning environment.

II. POLICY AND SANCTION

The use, possession, and/or distribution of illegal drugs and other prohibited substances on school property, while engaged in or attending a school activity, or while going to or returning from school, is prohibited by school policy as well as the law and is cause for removal from school. For this purpose, illegal drugs and other prohibited substances include alcohol, nonalcoholic beer, intoxicants, marijuana, controlled substances, imitation controlled substances, and drug paraphernalia.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES

The school staff shall maintain close coordination with other public agencies in the prevention of alcohol and other illegal drug use and the rehabilitation of those who use these prohibited substances.
