School Activity Funds

Equipment for School Activities

This policy supersedes Policy 5820.

I. PURPOSE

To help new schools provide equipment for school activity programs in order to lessen the burden of fund-raising on newly formed student organizations, parents, and community groups and to help existing schools provide equipment for school activities under special circumstances.

II. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance shall be provided each new school for acquiring such items as athletic equipment, band uniforms, playground equipment, and other items not included in the standard equipment complement provided normally by the School Board for each new school. Financial assistance shall be provided to existing schools in establishing new activities or supporting continuing activities under special circumstances.

III. FINANCIAL PROCEDURES

Unless specifically agreed to by the School Board, obligations of school activity funds shall not be binding obligations of the School Board. The School Board may permit the Superintendent to use appropriated funds for making grants or loans to schools for the purposes stated in section II. If assistance is provided by a loan, such loan is to be repaid according to a schedule agreed to by the principal and the Division Superintendent.
