Advisory Committees and School-Community Groups

Curriculum–Information and Feedback Meetings

This regulation supersedes Regulation 1707.6.

I. PURPOSE

To define the role and meeting schedule of curriculum information and feedback meetings.

II. SUMMARY OF CHANGES SINCE LAST PUBLICATION

This regulation has been completely revised and should be reviewed in its entirety.

III. ROLE OF THE CURRICULUM INFORMATION AND FEEDBACK MEETINGS

Curriculum information and feedback meetings for levels preK through 12 shall be established to provide input and receive updates on the Program of Studies:

English Language Arts	Mathematics
Fine Arts	Science
Foreign Language	Social Studies
Health and Physical Education	

The role of the information and feedback meetings is to provide information to and receive feedback from the public on curriculum development and implementation related to the subject areas.

IV. MEETINGS

The curriculum coordinator for each subject area shall serve as the chairperson for the curriculum information and feedback meetings. Meetings of curriculum shall be called by the chairpersons at a minimum of three times per year. Meeting topics and agendas will be announced to the public in advance of each meeting.

Each meeting will include a brief curriculum presentation and an opportunity for public input.

V. CONTENT ADVISORY GROUP

Each subject area will establish an advisory committee consisting of subject matter experts at the discretion of the assistant superintendent, Instructional Services Department. This committee will meet as needed to help guide curriculum changes.
