Standard Instructional Program

Personal Health and Hygiene (Sex Education)

This policy supersedes Policy 3204.

I. PURPOSE

To establish guidelines for a program of sex education.

II. SUMMARY OF CHANGES SINCE LAST PUBLICATION

The program implementation has been clarified by stating that the sex education program will meet the guidelines and standards of learning for the Virginia Department of Education. The category has also been corrected in order to be in compliance with the current version of Regulation 1104.

III. PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

An approved sex education program that meets Virginia Department of Education family life education guidelines and standards of learning shall be made available to all students at appropriate age levels.

IV. PROGRAM MATERIALS

A. Approval of Materials

Program or instructional materials shall be approved by the School Board, and no materials shall be used that are not approved.

B. Change of Materials

No change in the program or the instructional materials used shall be made without thorough public scrutiny and parental reaction.
