**Student Advisory Council to the Superintendent**

This policy supersedes Policy 1703.2

**I. PURPOSE**

To establish a student advisory council that will provide opportunity for valid student involvement in the operation of the school division based on democratic principles and procedures.

**II. SUMMARY OF CHANGES SINCE LAST PUBLICATION**

This policy has been reviewed, and there are no changes at this time.

**III. ROLE**

The role of the Student Advisory Council (SAC) is to advise the Superintendent and the School Board, advocate for the rights and interests of the students of Fairfax County Public Schools, enhance communication throughout the school system community, and elect the student representative to the Fairfax County School Board.
